How do I dispose of construction waste?

Construction materials are generally too big to be disposed of in your regular curbside pickup. The best way to dispose of construction waste is to rent a dumpster.

All non-hazardous waste can be thrown in a dumpster. Materials considered hazardous that need proper disposal include:

- Asbestos
- Lead
- Silica

There is a wide variety of building materials that can be reused or donated instead of being thrown away in a landfill.

New and gently used products such as windows, ceramic tiles, and light fixtures are all products that can easily be donated.

One great place to take new or gently used building materials is the Habitat for Humanity Restore.
