### What electronics need to be recycled?

As of 2009, all electronic devices were banned from landfills in Wisconsin by the DNR. These electronics include:

- Cell phones
- Any computer related electronic products
- All desktop printers
- All video players (DVD, VCR, etc.)
- External hard drives
- Fax machines
- Flash drives/USBs
- Anything that can plug into a computer
- Televisions

When e-waste gets disposed of in landfills the chemicals in them can leach out into the soil contaminating the soil and ground water and even the air.

Recycling electronics also helps to lower pollution, save raw materials, and save energy.
