

Campsite Reservation Policy

Calumet County Parks Department will start taking reservations for camping twelve (12) months in advance to the date of the first night of the reservation. EXCEPTION: Dates will be established for the first acceptance date for Memorial Day Weekend, Father's Day Weekend, 4th of July, and Labor Day Weekend.

A separate reservation must be made for each campsite and each stay. A non-refundable reservation fee will be charged for each reservation.

A camping reservation will be for a minimum of two consecutive nights or a maximum of 21 consecutive nights. A camper and all of their belongings must leave the park for a minimum of two nights before the 21 day limit starts over. This is from April 1st to December 1st.

From December 1st to April 1st Winter camping is available for a maximum of 14 consecutive nights and then the camper and all of their belongings must leave the park for a minimum of 7 consecutive nights before they can return.

Reservations for Memorial Day Weekend and Labor Day Weekend will be for a minimum of Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights. July 4th reservation minimum will vary according to the night this holiday falls upon.

Payment in full is required at the time the reservation is made.
